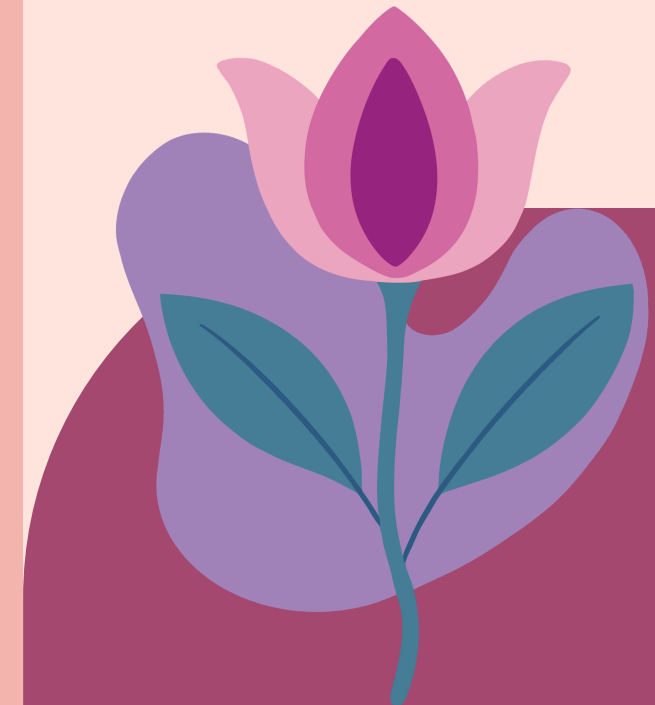

- Health professionals seeking advice or support

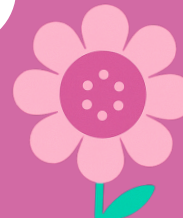

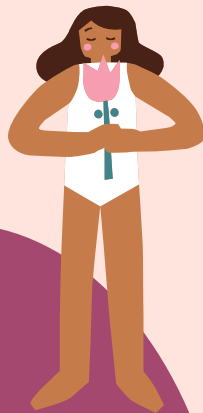
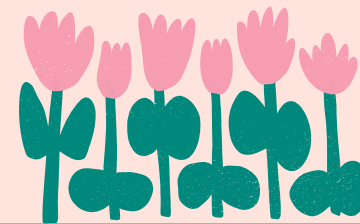
