Private patient in a public hospital

You can employ the services of a private obstetrician who is accredited to deliver at The Women's to manage your pregnancy and birth. They will see you for your appointments and deliver your baby. Your obstetrician would charge you to manage your pregnancy and then we would charge you a bed fee. Unless you have private health insurance, this fee would fall directly to you.

The bed fees are as follows:

Obstetric Accommodation <i>Deposit payable at 32 weeks, covers two-night stay but is not a guarantee of a two-night stay, and you may be discharged earlier than this, provided you are well enough.</i>	\$2,256.00 (non-refundable deposit)
Additional nights	\$1,128.00 per night
Insured for pregnancy <i>Your insurance will most likely only cover minimum benefits in a public hospital. With this level of insurance, you will be required to pay an out-of-pocket payment deposit (based on the minimum birthing episode fee).</i>	\$1,755.00 plus any excess applicable
Same day stay prior to birth	\$513.00
Overnight stay prior to birth	\$923.00

We do not charge an additional fee for caesarean deliveries. It is important to note that single rooms are not guaranteed at The Women's, even for private patients. Single rooms are allocated first to patients with specific medical or clinical need for a single room. Private patients desiring single rooms will be allocated this accommodation only if available single rooms are not medically required for other patients.
