

Childbirth Education Programs

The Royal Women's Hospital – 2024

The Women's Childbirth and Early Parenting education programs are available online or in person.

We offer a number of different educational options, all of which can be found on the Eventbrite management and ticketing website. Once on the website, each program will indicate if it is being offered either online or in-person.

- Three consecutive weeknights x 3-hour sessions: 6-9pm.
- Two consecutive weekends (Saturday or Sunday) x 4-hour sessions: 9.30am – 1.30pm.
- Two x 3-hour sessions for parents with a multiple pregnancy: 6-9pm.
- Two x 90-minutes sessions with either a Vietnamese or Mandarin interpreter: daytime.

- Progress of labour and birth
- Support in labour
- Assistance with birth
- Practical coping methods during labour
- Understanding breastfeeding
- Safe sleeping and settling
- Communicating with your baby
